MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES**General:**

1. As a garden member I will abide by all the rules associated with the Dalyellup Community Garden Inc.
2. I will not interfere with the rights and opportunities of others using the plots and garden in general.
3. I understand that my involvement at the garden is a privilege and will behave accordingly.
4. I will be responsible for the removal of my own garden waste and dispose of it appropriately. If I store any materials, it will be within my own plot or communal shed, space permitting.
5. When I use tools I will always be aware of the safety of others and myself.
6. I will be responsible for the supervision of any children I bring to the garden.
7. I understand that no domestic pets will be allowed in the Dalyellup Community Garden at any time.
8. I understand that my participation at the garden is at my own risk. The Dalyellup Community Garden Inc. is not liable for any injury to me, or my invited guests nor for the loss of any of my or their possessions.
9. I appreciate the need for security of the Dalyellup Community Garden and will ensure that any suspicious activity is reported, also, securing the site and locking all gates is my responsibility as appropriate.
10. I will only hand water my plot by bucket or watering can as a top up to the reticulation that will be supplied.
11. Any changes to my circumstances relating to my plot or membership (i.e., holidays, health, change of address etc.) should be notified to the Committee if the duration exceeds 1 month.
12. I will abide by strict organic gardening principles for the management of pests and diseases.

I understand that my plot may be forfeited if:

1. If do not pay my membership fee on time;
2. If I do not contribute to at least 2 working bees at the garden plots and at least one community garden event per year;

3. If I do not maintain a weed free plot, boundary and surrounding pathways; and/or
4. If I erect a fence around my plot
5. If my plot has been neglected for one month; I will be notified by phone or email. I will need to attend to my plot within 2 weeks from that contact. If no action is taken on my part then I understand I forfeit my plot.
6. I understand that Dalyellup Community Garden Incorporated may allocate a plot for my use only, and I understand that I may not transfer the use of my plot to any other person.

Conflict and Pests:

1. The only conflict initiated by me will be with weeds and pests, which I will attack with biological means rather than chemical.

Membership Entitlements:
